Monthly Board Meeting
Town of New Haven, Dunn County
March 8, 2018

The special board meeting of the Town of New Haven was called to order by Chairperson Marv Prestrud at the New Haven Town Hall on Thursday, March 8, 2018, at 7:10 PM.

ROLL CALL

Prestrud, Carlsrud, Schoonover and Duerst were present. Ulrich was absent. Townspeople were also in attendance.

NEW BUSINESS

Wade Iverson, the town's full-time patrolman, took a job with the St. Croix County Highway Department and his last day working for the Town of New Haven will be Friday, March 23, 2018.

The board reviewed the ad to be placed in the Tribune Press Reporter, application and cover letter to go with the application. The information will also be placed on the Town's website.

The board discussed what to do if help was needed with plowing or sanding in between March 23rd and when the new patrolman starts. Part-time patrolman, Jerry Malean, can help as well as possibly hiring some additional part-time work or contract it out. Motion by Carlsrud, second by Schoonover, that if necessary the board will hire temporary help and that the temporary help will complete a W-4 and I-9 form so they can be paid as employees. Motion carried unanimously.

The tax paperwork will not be necessary if a contractor who uses his own equipment is hired to do the work.

The board decided to hold a meeting on Monday, March 26, 2018 at 7:00 PM at which time they will review the applications received and set up an interview schedule.

Prestrud declared the meeting adjourned.
