ELECTION WORKER SHIFTS
AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CONDUCTION OF ELECTIONS

At a regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of New Haven, Dunn County, Wisconsin, held February 5, 2008, a quorum being present and a majority of the Board voting therefore, said Board does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1

That pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 7.30(1), the Town of New Haven creates the following ordinance:

The Town of New Haven shall allow for the selection of two (2) or more sets of election officials to work at different times on election day and permit the Town Clerk or the Clerk's designee to establish different working hours for different officials assigned at the same polling place.

SECTION 2

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby, to such extent repealed.

SECTION 3

That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force, after its passage and publication.
